Last year the Soccer World Cup tournament was played in Russia. In the final game, France won the match with Croatia with a score of 4 to 2. But Japan did well, too. They were in the top 16. Unfortunately, they lost their first game in the finals, but to the end, they showed very good sportsmanship. Did you know that before they left Russia, the Japanese team cleaned their locker room very well? The staff said, "The room was spotless." Also, they wrote a simple note saying, "Thank you," written in Russian. What a nice act!

But did you know that there is going to be another World Cup this year? And it will be played here in Japan. Two of the games will be played in Iwate! No, it isn't the Soccer World Cup. It is the Rugby World Cup.

So let's *compare soccer and rugby. A team gets points when they score a goal. In soccer, it is only one point per goal, but in rugby you can get 2, 3 or 5 points, *depending on the kind of goal you score. There are 11 players on a soccer team, but there are 15 on a rugby team. One of the biggest differences is the shape of the ball. I am sure you know soccer balls. Rugby balls are very different. They are shaped almost like an egg. It is shaped more like an American football than a soccer ball. Another big difference is that anyone can use their hands in rugby. Of course, in soccer, only the goalkeepers can use their hands.

If rugby sounds like an interesting sport, you will not have to go far to see games in the Rugby World Cup. The Rugby World Cup is not very old. In fact, the 2019 World Cup will only be the ninth time. Like the Soccer World Cup, it is played every four years. The last one was in 2015 and was in England. The winning team was New Zealand. The one after Japan will be in 2023 and will be in France. This is the first time it will be played in Asia, and of course, Japan.

A **The event** will be held from September 20 to November 2. The opening match will be at Tokyo Stadium in Chofu. The final match will be played at the International Stadium Yokohama in Kanagawa. Two matches will be played right here in Iwate, at the Kamaishi Recovery Memorial Stadium. Did you know Kamaishi has a long history with rugby? Thanks to this history, we will have a chance to see two World Cup matches *up close and personal.

If you do not know much about rugby, this is your chance to learn a lot more about the sport. Let's learn more about rugby!
