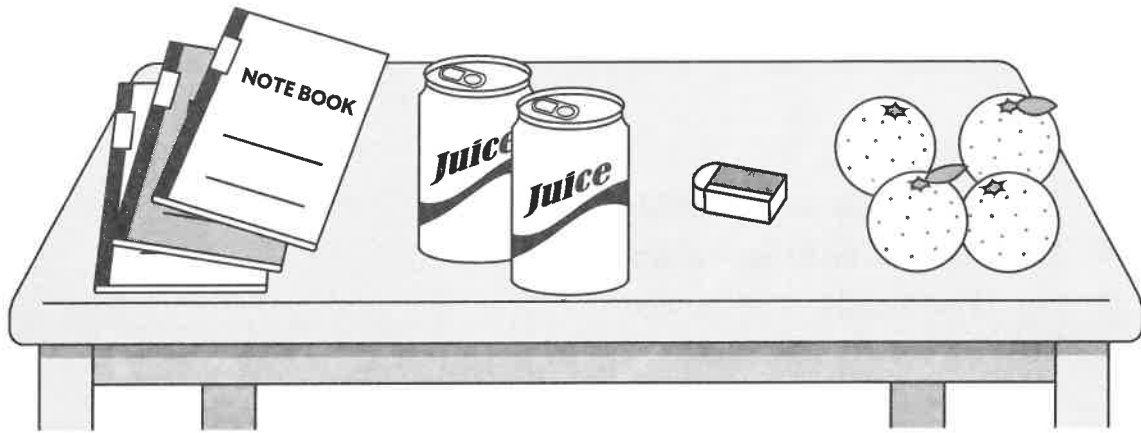

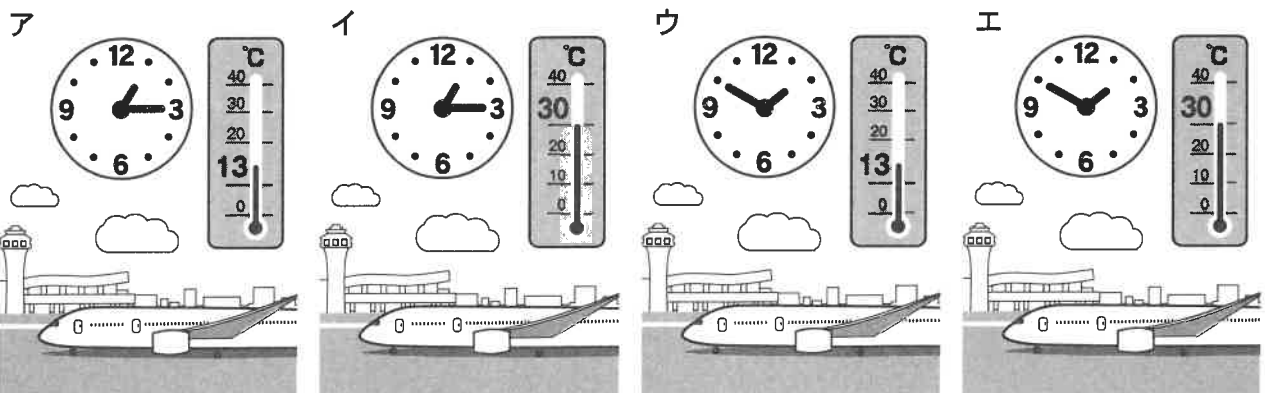

May: I want to join a club, but I don't know which one to join.

Noa: Our school has many different clubs. If you like sports, for girls we have volleyball and basketball.

May: I like sports, but I also want to try something Japanese. Are there any Japanese sports?

Noa: Yes. Our school has *kendo*. Do you know *kendo*?

May: Isn't that some kind of bamboo sword fighting? I don't think I can do that. Is there anything else?

Noa: Actually, I belong to the *kyudo* club.

May: *Kyudo*? What's that?

Noa: It's Japanese archery.

May: Japanese archery? Isn't that a sport for boys?

Noa: Of course boys practice *kyudo*, but many girls also join.

May: What can you tell me about *kyudo*?

Noa: It has a long history. There are some old pictures that show people using *longbows. But it really became popular with samurai many centuries later. As samurai became more *political, it lost some popularity, but it became popular again during the Meiji *Era. Now, it is popular among some high school students.

May: Is it difficult?

Noa: A little bit. I started in my first year in high school as a beginner. My aunt used to do it, and there is an anime about *kyudo* called *Tsurune* that I like very much. I thought it looked cool, so I wanted to try it. The special costumes we wear, called *hakama*, are also really cool.

May: What do you like best about *kyudo*?

Noa: I remember the first time I hit the target. It was a wonderful feeling.

May: Is there anything you don't like about *kyudo*?

Noa: Sometimes the *string on the bow hits your arm or face, and that *hurts. But we have to keep trying, because *kyudo* helps you build up concentration, patience, and strength.

May: It sounds interesting. Do you think I should try it?

Noa: Of course. I think you will like it very much. Let's go together.

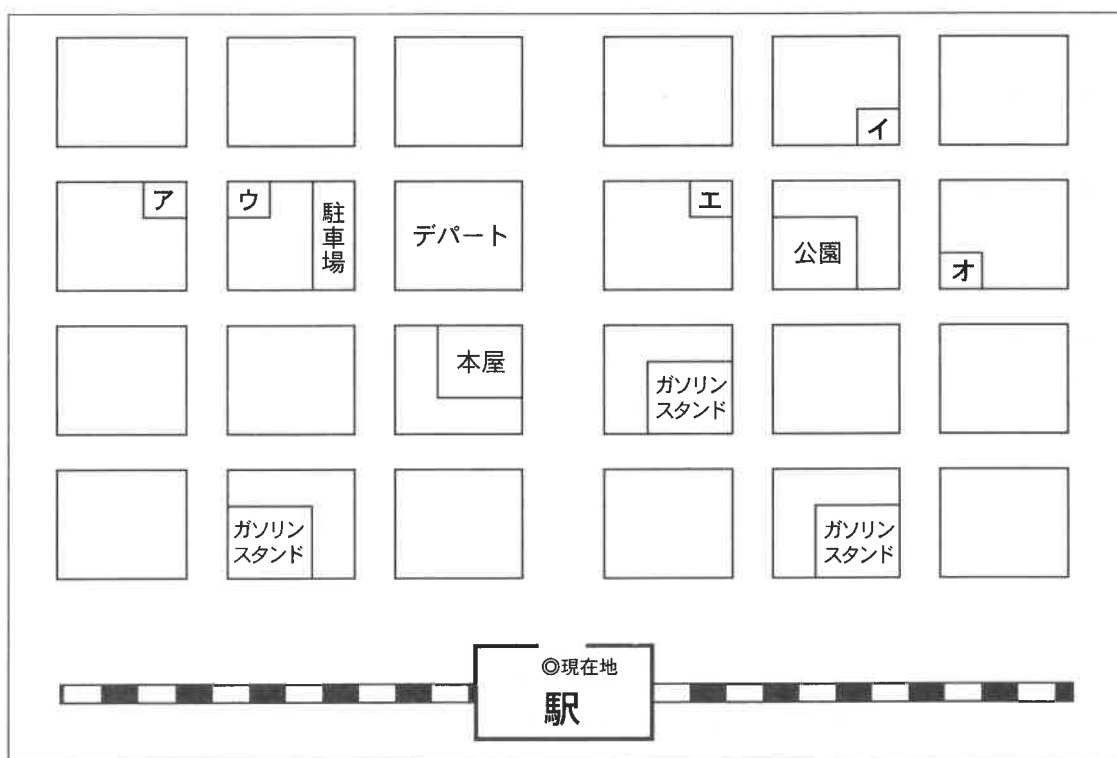

(第1段落)

Some people love to study English. There are many reasons. They may like foreign music, TV, or movies. Or, they may want to become friends with people from other countries. Another reason is so that they can get a good job.

(第2段落)

On the other hand, there are many people who do not like to study English. They wonder why they have to study a language that they think they will never use. Some wish to spend their time studying other subjects. For these reasons, it can be difficult.

(第3段落)

*Whether you like studying English or not, there is one way that can make it much more fun. It is (A). That is the first of the four language skills: Listening, Speaking, (B), and Writing. *Whatever your native language is, the first skill you pick up is listening. As a baby, you hear your parents and others speaking to you all the time. At first you cannot understand what they are saying, but in time, you begin to understand what they are saying. The same is true when studying a foreign language such as (C).

(第4段落)

So how can you practice listening? Here is one idea that was not *available until around 20 years ago. Do you have a DVD player? If so, you can practice listening to English very easily.

(第5段落)

Step one is to find a DVD that interests you. Some teachers may choose a DVD for you to watch, but what if you do not like the topic? Some people enjoy love stories. Others *prefer science fiction, drama, comedies, or action. If you go to a DVD rental store, you can find a wide *variety to choose from. Find something that you think you would enjoy. It can be a movie. But some people think that TV series are better. Movies are only about two hours long. But if you watch a TV series, you can *get used to the characters and the story over a long period of time.

(第6段落)

Once you find something you like, then you can start listening. The good thing about DVDs is that you can choose the language you listen to and the language written in the *subtitles. So if you are watching a DVD for the first time and do not know what people are saying, you can set the language to Japanese and watch it. Then you can understand the story. But that is not enough. Next, switch the settings to listen in English with Japanese subtitles. This way, you can still follow the story, and also get some English practice. Watch the DVD again. This time, listen in English with English subtitles. This way, you can also practice reading, but that is not the important thing. The important thing is that you listen carefully. Finally, watch the DVD a fourth time.

This time you should watch it while listening to English and with no subtitles. After watching the same DVD four times, you should be able to *improve your listening ability.
